Our goal is the success of each athlete and team. Dynamic Diamondz reserves the right to move an athlete from one team to another at any point in the season. Dynamic Diamondz is NOT responsible for reimbursement for any travel arrangements if your child is moved from one team to another, made an alternate, or removed from the program.



Practice Attendance Policy



Attendance at all practices is **mandatory** for athletes. The success of our teams is contingent upon the commitment of each member to participate consistently. This commitment may require personal sacrifices. Please refer to the schedule for practice days and times listed below. Additional practices may be scheduled as needed. To promote family time, primary team practices will be conducted during the week. We aim to provide reasonable notice for any additions or changes to the existing schedule. Your cooperation is vital for both the team's success and the individual progression of each athlete.

Please note that excessive tardiness and absences will incur penalties: a fee of \$25 for the first instance, \$50 for the second, \$75 for the third, and \$100 for the fourth. Continued infractions may result in immediate removal from the team.



All dates are tentative until the final schedules are released. We will make every effort to provide accurate dates to families with as much advance notice as possible. It is important to emphasize that if Dynamic Diamondz qualifies for Nationals or Summit, attendance from all athletes is mandatory. Consequently, the competition and fee schedule will be adjusted accordingly. Please note that the current fee schedule does not include costs associated with these additional competitions. For Nationals, Regionals, or Summit, practice requirements will intensify, and attendance will be mandatory. Athletes are expected to participate in all additional competitions without exception. If an athlete is unable to commit to these events, participation in our Elite or Limited teams is not recommended."





Competitions / Performances Attendance Policy

The athletes have worked all season long for these weekends. Please plan your schedule accordingly. If for any reason your child does not attend or compete at the event, they will forfeit ANY and ALL gifts, medals, jackets, sweatshirts etc. for that competition.

These handouts will be given to the person that is substituting for your child at this event. If there is no substitution then the athlete that is absent will still forfeit all gifts, awards, etc from the competition company.

All athletes are required to perform both days of a 2-day event. If your child has to miss only (1) day, they will have to miss both days. This is for the betterment of the team at competition. Please remember there are **NO Refunds** for competition/performance/coaches fees. You will be responsible for paying the fees for the person that is substituting for your child if they will not be competing.

<u>Arrival / Departure Times at Competitions</u>

Please understand, when athletes do NOT arrive by the posted arrival time (set by Dynamic Diamondz), it creates so much stress on our coaches and our athletes that are competing. We want everyone to have an enjoyable stress free, fun day. It is very important that athletes arrive according to our schedule. Pre-Warm-up: Teams may have a pre-warm-up or additional practice times at a competition.

This will be decided based upon each teams needs the day of the event. Situations and accidents can happen. Following the Dynamic Diamondz schedule as opposed to the event producers ensures that we will have an entire team present. This will give our coaches and athletes an ample amount of time to make necessary adjustments within routines so the team does not suffer at competitions (i.e.missing an athlete).

TRAVELING - Out of state competitions

Dynamic Diamondz will be providing all of our families with the dates, times, and locations of all out-of-town events. Dyanamic Diamondz families MUST arrive to these destinations no later than 5:00 pm the evening prior to the competition day*

When traveling out of state, the athlete MUST arrive in the competition city by 5 pm the evening prior to the event start. If the competition begins on a Saturday, the athlete must arrive to the city NO LATER THAN 5:00 PM on FRIDAY. *There may be exceptions to this rule. The competition schedule will reflect travel days. Its important to note that these competitions are not intended as family vacations; our primary focus is on competing, Therefore, its essential to keep the competition schedule in mind and ensure that athletes and their families are available for all required activities, such as practices, performances, awards ceremonies, and other events. Details plans and itineraries will be posted on stackteam before each trip to keep everyone informed and prepared.

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Additional Team Information

Crossover Policies

Crossovers at Dynamic Diamondz are athletes who possess the skills to contribute to multiple teams within a single season. The decision to designate an athlete as a crossover is made by Dynamic Diamondz coaches based on skill level and team needs.

- Athletes demonstrating high skill levels, commitment, positive energy, and a strong work ethic may be required to participate in more than one team.
 - Crossover athletes are expected to attend all practices for both of their assigned teams.
- The Head Coach reserves the right to discontinue crossover participation at any time for the benefit of the athlete or their teams.
- Crossover athletes do not pay a second tuition but are responsible for additional fees for each team, such as competition fees, music, choreography, etc. These fees can be divided into multiple payments.

LIABILITY RELEASE

I, _____, fully acknowledge and understand that participation in any activity

involving motion, height, athletic activity, and/or the use of gymnastic equipment (e.g., Tumble-Trak,
Trampoline, etc.) carries inherent risks of serious injury. I hereby agree to hold Dynamic Diamondz, its staff
and
officers, harmless from any injury or resulting expenses that may occur during such activities. Furthermore, I acknowledge and understand the risks associated with exposure to viruses, including but not limited to COVID-19, which is thought to spread mainly from person to person and through direct contact. I release and discharge all rights and claims against Dynamic Diamondz and all its representatives including those related to natural disasters and health conditions.
PUBLICITY RELEASE
I,, hereby grant Dynamic Diamondz the unrestricted right to use my name, likeness, or appearance in any cheerleading or tumbling advertising or marketing materials. This includes but is not limited to, competition posters, calendars, film material, photographs, video material, or other promotional materials in any form, content, or medium to promote or marketing, Dynamic Diamondz.

Policies and expectations

- **Personal Items:** Please do not leave personal belongings in the gym. It is advisable to keep them at home or with a parent, as the gym is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- **Team Apparel:** All team apparel should be labeled with the athlete's name to facilitate the return of misplaced items.
- **Gossip Policy:** Gossip is strictly prohibited. We ask that you refrain from discussing athletes, coaches, parents, or other programs, as this behavior is harmful. Concerns should be addressed directly with coaching management. <u>Parents or athletes engaging in gossip will be removed from the program.</u>
- **Meeting Protocol:** Concerns involving athletes and/or parents will be addressed in a meeting with all parties present, including the coach and program owner/director.
- **Language Conduct:** The use of profanity or abusive language by athletes or parents is unacceptable.
- **Substance Use:** The use of alcohol, tobacco products, and drugs by Dynamic Diamondz athletes is strictly prohibited.
- **Social Media Guidelines:** Negative comments or discussions regarding any aspect of the Dynamic Diamondz program on social media or other platforms are not permitted. Engaging in such behavior may result in dismissal from the program.
- **Commitment to the Program:** Any threats to quit, remove an athlete from a team, or change gyms (even after the season concludes) will result in immediate dismissal from the program without a refund. Such behavior undermines both the athlete's and the team's success.
- **Access to Training Areas:** Only coaches and athletes are permitted in the gym training areas. Parents, relatives, and friends are encouraged to utilize the designated viewing area, where wireless internet access is available.
- **Competition Officials:** Athletes and parents are not permitted to communicate with competition officials for any reason.
- **Representation:** Athletes and parents may not represent Dynamic Diamondz in any official capacity.
- **Intellectual Property:** Dynamic Diamondz logos and team names are trademarked and remain the property of Dynamic Diamondz.
- **Apparel Regulations:** All Dynamic Diamondz apparel must be purchased through or approved by Dynamic Diamondz. Reproduction of any items featuring the gym name and/or logo is strictly prohibited without written consent from the owner.

- **Stay Informed:** It is the responsibility of each athlete and parent to stay informed about team activities. Please regularly check emails, texts, and team communications.
- **Team Mom Etiquette:** The role of Team Mom is not a paid position. We expect respectful treatment of Team Moms, as they work closely with the coaching staff. Please discuss any concerns with the program director or your child's coach at an appropriate time.
- **Sporting Attitude:** Competitive cheerleading is subjective; teams may experience wins and losses that may seem unjust. This presents an opportunity to teach children to exhibit humility in victory and graciousness in defeat, reinforcing character and sportsmanship.
- **Gym Use Policy:** Dynamic Diamondz is not a babysitting service. While we encourage athletes to utilize the gym for skill improvement, they should not be dropped off and left unattended during non-participation periods.
- **Post-Season Participation:** Bids for post-season competitions, such as Worlds, National and Summit, do not guarantee participation for the gym or individual athletes; such decisions are at the discretion of the program owner/director.
- **Behavior Expectations:** Appropriate behavior is expected from all athletes and family members during competitions and team outings.
- **Fundraising Policy:** Dynamic Diamondz offers various fundraising opportunities throughout the season. Funds raised should be submitted and used exclusively for account balances, with a 20%-25% holdback allocated for the gym from all fundraisers.

PRACTICES & COMPETITIONS

Athletes must understand the importance of attending ALL scheduled practices.

- Practices may be changed or added at any time during the season. PLEASE be flexible.
- Tardiness and/or missed practices affect the entire team. Excessive tardiness and/or absences will
 jeopardize an athlete's position on the team and may result in dismissal without refund.
- In summer months, athletes are expected at all practices unless on scheduled vacation pre-approved by coaches. Coaches must be informed well in advance of all vacations.
- During Fall & Spring, athletes are expected to attend EVERY practice. Practices are MANDATORY.
- Only graded school functions are excused as OK for missed practice. Please notify your coach, and office, well in advance.
- In the event of illness please contact your coach and the office.
- Unless contagious, it is expected that athletes attend practice even when not participating in physical activities

Initals:				

- Unexcused absences may result in an athlete being moved to an alternate position on team or being replaced.
- Placement is at the sole discretion of each coach.
- For the SAFETY of the team, any member missing practice for ANY reason, two weeks prior to a competition, may be removed from the routine for the upcoming competition.
- We ask that athletes not be punished by withholding them from practice or competition as it negatively affects the entire program.
- Athletes are expected to remain in the practice area at all times during scheduled practices. Use of cell phones during practice is PROHIBITED. If you need to get in touch with your child, please call the front office.
- Athletes MUST come prepared for each practice. Assigned practice attire must be worn at all
 practices. Additional practice-wear is available for sale. For the safety of athletes, jewelry may NOT be
 worn during practice. Finger nails must be kept short for the safety reasons.
- At team practices, your opinion does not count. All team decision making is at the sole discretion of the coaching staff.
- The coaching staff may close practice at any time for any reason. Closed practice (athletes and coaches only allowed in gym) is intended to help avoid distraction and gain focus. Closed practice typically occurs the week of or weeks leading up to a competition.
- Punctuality on competition days is a MUST. Athletes are required to be aware of all scheduled meeting times and to be on time. Tardiness severely affects a team's performance creating a stressful environment and timing concerns for the team and coaching staff. Tardiness will result in consequences for the athlete.
- Athletes are expected to wear the assigned outfits at each competition. All jewelry is prohibited when in uniform.
- Please support all teams! All team members are expected to support & cheer on other Dynamic Diamondz teams. While we would love for everyone to stay and support all teams, you are REQUIRED to stay to watch your assigned teams. Prior to each event, the staff will plan assignments for supporting other Dynamic Diamondz teams based on competition length and the number of teams competing. Failure to support assigned teams will result in consequences to the athlete.
- All athletes and parents MUST exhibit good sportsmanship and character at competitions. Please be respectful of all programs and competitors. We are proud to maintain the highest standards of competitive behavior.
- If an athlete fails to show up at a competition without prior knowledge, he/she will be dismissed from the program immediately.
- For the safety of the athlete as well as the team, Dynamic Diamondz reserves the right to reposition athletes based on improvement or progression of their skills.

Financial Commitment

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT CONTRACT

Competitive cheerleading is an expensive sport. The following is a summary of the terms being agreed to by the Dynamic Diamondz and the Parent/Guardian of:

Athlete's Name:	

Parents/guardians signing this document assume full responsibility for all costs of being a member of Dynamic Diamondz, regardless of any other agreements. These responsibilities include, but are not limited to: monthly tuition, annual gym registration, uniforms, camp, travel, practice-wear, competition fees, makeup, shoes, bows, choreography, music, etc.

- Dynamic Diamondz has the right to remove an athlete from his/her team at any time for failure to meet financial obligations.
- Any team agreement regarding the Dynamic Diamondz and the Athlete listed above will apply the same terms as this contract.
- Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of each month. Payments for this season begin in May, 2025 and run through April, 2026. This is a year-long commitment.
- Monthly tuition and fees will be set up as electronic drafts from credit/debit cards. Payments will be drafted on the 1st of each month.
- Dynamic Diamondz accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express.
- Monthly tuition does not fluctuate based on the number of, or duration of, practices Monthly tuition covers the cost of training but does not pay for the right to perform.
- Vacations and/or time off will not be pro-rated.
- All payment due dates must be met. Any unpaid classes, merchandise, and other miscellaneous charges on account will be drafted from card on file if not cleared up by 10th of each month.
- Late payments WILL result in a \$35 per month late fee. Payments not received within 3 days of due date are considered late.
- PAST DUE accounts may result in athlete sitting out at practice or may result in athlete being placed in an alternate position or removed from program.
- Dynamic Diamondz Automatic Debit Authorization form must be turned in at time of registration
- Any payments resulting in NSF (non-sufficient funds), declined or expired credit cards, returned check and electronic debits, etc. will incur a \$35 service fee. It is your responsibility to update the information you have with us if it changes (examples include: credit card number, expiration date, etc.).



Financial Commitment

- An athlete's account must be in good standing and current in order to be able to participate in practices, competitions, and/or special events.
- Funds received for an athlete's account will be applied first to any overdue tuition and/or fees. Dynamic Diamondz will NOT order practice wear, or uniforms for athletes with past due accounts, no exceptions will be made.
- All tuition and/or fees must be current before an athlete will be allowed to participate in additional classes, private lessons, or making pro-shop purchases.
- Payments will be applied to one's account, if past due, before being applied to uniforms, post season competitions, etc.
- Should an athlete choose to leave or be asked to leave Dynamic Diamondz for any reason prior to the
 end of the season, any and all funds are completely non-refundable and non-transferable. Therefore, the
 Parent/Guardian(s) are still responsible for making payments.
- Because Dynamic Diamondz pays out the majority of its expenses prior to receiving all athlete's
 payments and allows for participants to make payment over time, any person withdrawing from the
 Competitive program after TEAM CHOROGRAPHY or July 1, 2025(Whichever comes first) will be
 financially responsible for all remaining TEAM fees in Dynamic Diamondz. Auto drafts will remain in place
 as agreed. Failure to do so will result in account being sent to collections.
- Dynamic Diamondz reserves the right to turn over all delinquent accounts to a collection agency and/or the courts, and the parent/athlete will be responsible for all additional costs incurred.
- Dynamic Diamondz offers a 10% discount for prepayment of entire year's fees/tuition (uniform, warm-up, admin fee, team items, not included).
- All accounts must be current in order for athlete to be able to compete at ANY POST SEASON COMPETITION.
- The sole and exclusive jurisdiction for any lawsuit arising out of or relating to this agreement shall be Montgomery County, TX. By signing below, Parent/Guardian(s) waive all jurisdictional defenses.
- Due to the time-sensitive nature of many of the expenses incurred by the Dynamic Diamondz, such as competition entry fees, the times and dates for payment specified in this agreement are vital and mandatory to the contract.
- In the event of a failure to pay any of the specified payments on the due date, time being of the essence hereof, Dynamic Diamondz may, without notice or demand, declare the entire principal sum immediately due and payable at the sole discretion of the Dynamic Diamondz.
- The failure on the part of the Dynamic Diamondz to enforce or require timely compliance with any term or
 provision of this Agreement shall not be deemed to be a waiver or relinquishment of rights or obligations
 arising hereunder, nor shall any such failure preclude the enforcement of any term or provision or avoid
 the liability for any breach of this agreement.



Financial Commitment

- If any court finds that any provision of this agreement is invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, that provision shall, to the extent required, be deemed to be deleted, and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this agreement shall not be affected.
- In the event that Dynamic Diamondz prevails on an action arising from this Agreement, the Parent/Guardian(s) agree to pay for attorney fees and court costs.
- Dynamic Diamondz provides numerous fundraising opportunities throughout the season. This is a great way to offset expenses, so please be sure to take advantage of these opportunities.
- Each athlete will be required to be usasf certified, a separate fee required to be paid directly to usasf.
- ***Quitting the Team*** There is a strict no refund policy for athletes who quit or are removed from the team. A buy out fee of \$500 applies in addition to the full program balance. Parents acknowledge and agree to these terms upon signing.

- A No, once our season starts we will close off practice to parents and visitors.
